SHOW SCHEDULE

Please Note Venue for this show

Venue: Nambour State Primary School Hall on Cnr Coronation Ave and School Street. Enter School Street and turn right into school drop off zone. Parking on road in front of the Hall. (See map on page 2)

Entries: To be received by MONDAY evening 9.00pm, 10th July 2023,
(Please double check your entries, as incorrect entries will be scratched on show day)

Colour Schedule: As per SQBBA colour schedule (current colour schedule on page 5 of this schedule)

Staging: All exhibits must be staged between 7.30 & 8.30am on the day of the show.

Entry Fee: Entry \$1 (max \$20). Club preference is for pick up of stickers on the show day,
However postage is available for \$2, if you require stickers to be posted.

Classes: **Young Birds:** Must be rung with an ANBC approved 2022 Brown ring.
Old Birds: Must be rung with an ANBC approved ring (pre 2022 Brown rung).
Juveniles Must be rung with an ANBC approved 2023 Blue ring
NestFeather Must have NestFeather traits
Note: All birds exhibited must be owned and bred by the exhibitor.

Rings: Rings must bear the approved ANBC symbol. Split rings are not permitted.
Show Manager to do spot Ring checks.

Labels: To be affixed to bottom right hand corner of cage. *(Please assist by fixing label as high as possible in corner of cage to prevent being covered by staging rail).*

Sprays: All Show Cages must contain **Millet Sprays/Bobs (No loose seed).**
If required, packs of Millet sprays will be available at the show.

Rules: As per rules of SQBBA Inc. *(Purchased birds cannot be shown).*

Cages: Only show cages which meet the A.N.B.C. show cage specification will be accepted.
Any exhibits in dirty, marked or damaged cages may not be considered for awards.

Judging: Judging to commence at 9.00am. The judge's decision will be final in all matters of merit.

Exhibits: All birds will be considered the property of the Association during the period of the show and they must not be touched or removed without the permission of the Show Manager. All birds entered are at the sole risk of the exhibitor and the Association will not be held responsible for loss or injury.

Food & Drink: Morning Tea will be supplied (no cost) plus tea & coffee supplied all day. Cold drinks will also be available. Bacon and egg rolls will be available till 10am and instead of a sit down lunch, a sausage sizzle will be available throughout the day at a nominal cost.

Awards: Presentation of Awards will take place when Judging & Computer work is completed.

Removal: Removal of birds, directly following presentation. Show Manager will advise.

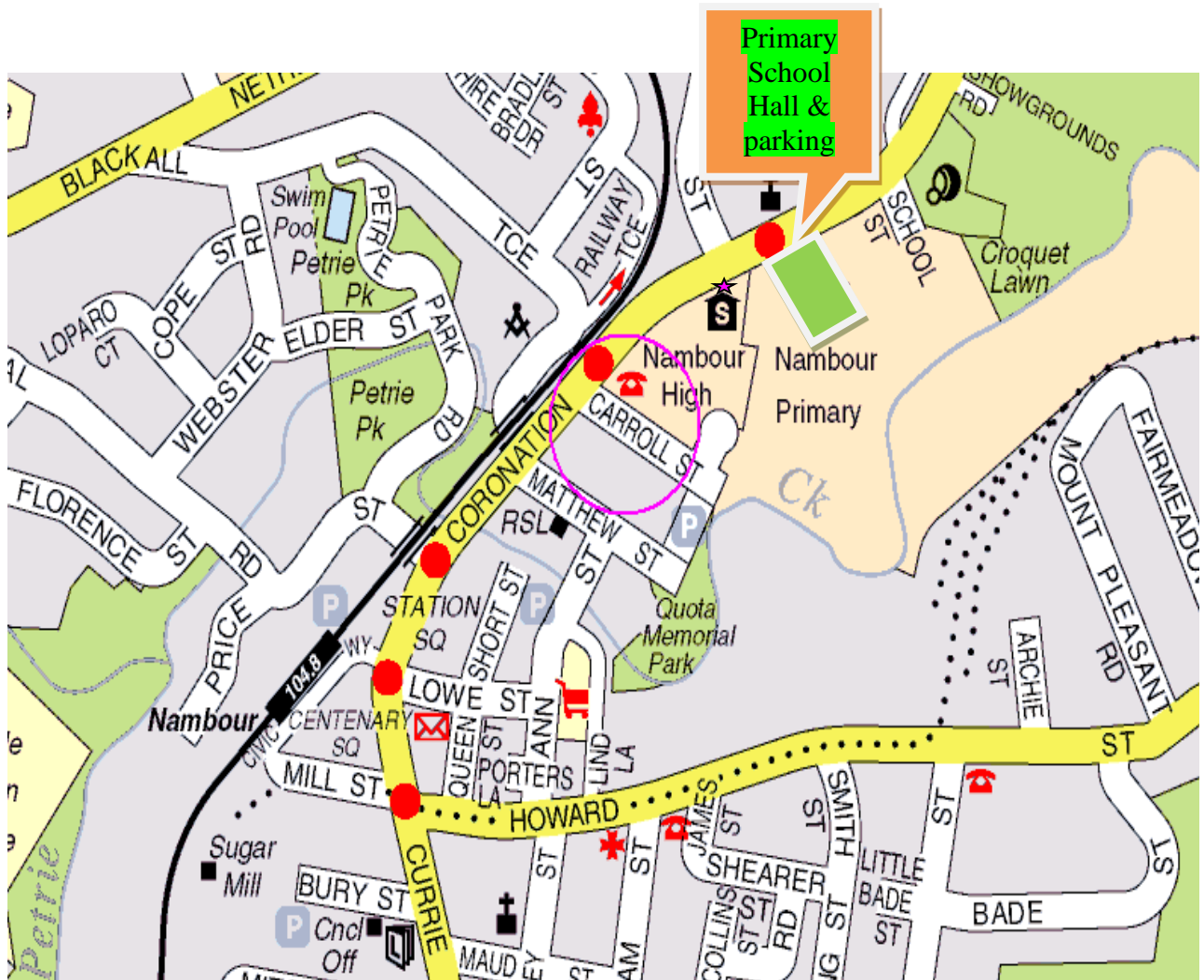
