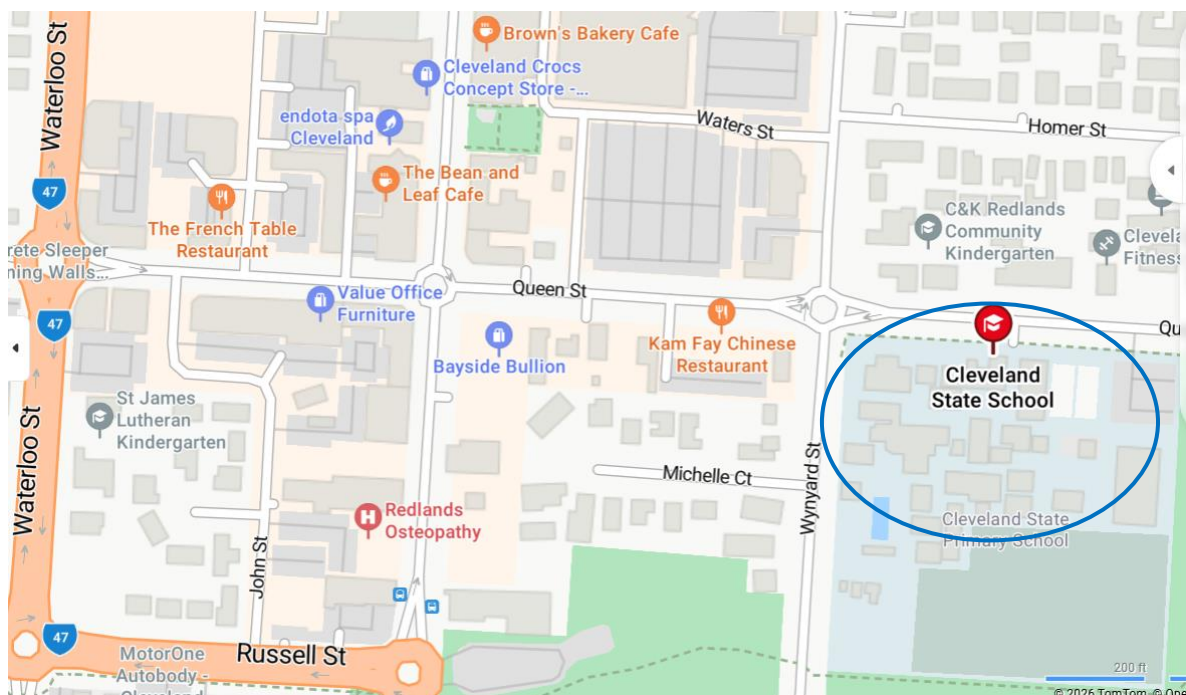
Interstate bidders

AUCTION RULES

1. Prior to the start of the auction each intending bidder is required to complete a registration form & receive a bidder's number.
2. The registration form will ask for your address contact number & payment details.
3. The bidder's number will be required to purchase any lot / lots at auction and must be shown to the auctioneer at the fall of the hammer.
4. Judging Sticks and Carry Cages will not be allowed into Auction Room. The Birds must not be interfered with or subjected to sticks, pens, or similar objects. **SMOKING** will **NOT** be permitted in the auction room at any time.
5. All lots will be submitted in catalogue order; however, if necessary, the organizers reserve the right to make any alterations, additions or deletions to the catalogue order.
6. All conditions and warranties expressed or implied by law are hereby excluded and as all lots are open for inspection prior to the commencement of the sale, the same are sold with all faults, if any. Therefore, no compensation shall be made in respect of any faults or imperfection or error of description of any lots sold or otherwise. At the fall of the hammer each lot shall be at the purchaser's risk.
7. After the fall of the hammer no party will be allowed to retract his / her bid.
8. At the fall of the hammer the highest bidder shall be the purchaser, and in the event of any disputes arising the lot in dispute shall be put up again and the auctioneer's decision will be final.
9. The auctioneer reserves the right to accept or refuse any bid without having to state the reason or reasons thereof.
10. Telephone bidding will be available provided **prior arrangements** have been made. Payment arrangements must be confirmed before the auction.
11. Payment for goods on the day shall be by **CASH, MASTERCARD, VISA** only. There will be no surcharge on Credit Card purchases. Personal cheques will not be accepted on the day of the sale.
12. Successful purchasers of lots will be required to take their purchases with them at the completion of the auction.
13. If any successful bidder shall fail to pay for their purchases on the day the vendor or his/her agents have the right to resell the lot in any manner they think proper.
14. It is preferred that birds are collected at the completion of the auction.
15. Purchases may be collected 20 mins after the completion of the auction. A receipt of purchase must be obtained from the cashier upon payment of the lot, then proceed to the allocated collection point with their carry cage and evidence of purchase. The purchaser will be required to remove the bird or birds from the sale cage and transfer it or them to their own cage. The vendor, or his/her agents, the auctioneer or any staff will not be handling the birds. It is the sole responsibility of each purchaser to handle his/her own birds at collection.

Please note that carry cages will not be available at the auction & it is the responsibility of the purchaser to have their own cages.

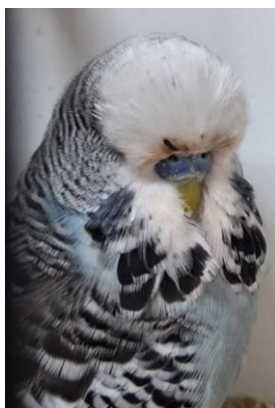
Phil Dickson - PGP1 budgerigars are a father and son partnership who have been breeding birds together for the last 40 years.

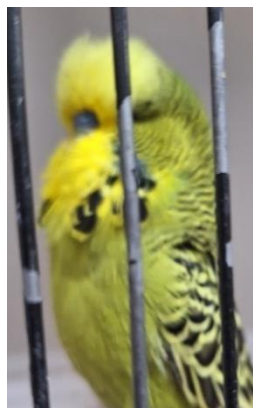

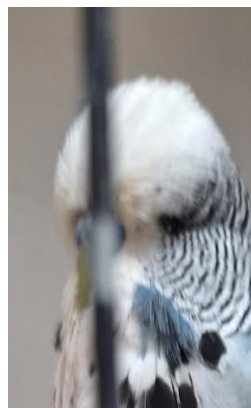

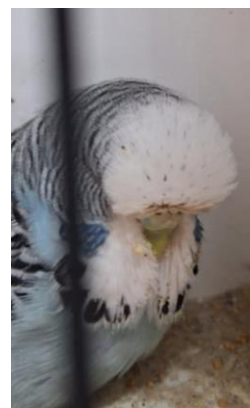

Ian Schneider – A National Judge and Open Breeder from North and Central Queensland. Ian Started breeding budgerigars in 1981 and is well respected breeding a quality stud of Budgerigars. Ian has won 2 ANBC National Logies first in the Normal Blue Class in 1997 followed in 1998 by the Opaline Class win. He has had numerous other high placings. In 2017, he had 6 budgies represent at the Mackay ANBC National Show, one of his highest placing was third in the Spangle DF Class, in 2018, placed 13th in the Normal Grey Class, 8th ,9th and 12th in Spangle Double Factor, 13th in Opaline AOSV, 16th in Spangle ASC, and 13th in the Hens Class. In 2019, Ian had 7 Budgies selected into the team. At the 2022 ANBC National Show placed 12th in Green, 16th and 21st in Grey Green, 15th in Grey, 17th in Lutino, 5th, and 13th in Cinnamon wing and 8th and 16th in the Hens class. Once again in 2023 representing very well at the Nationals with a 10th Grey Green, 16th Blue, 13th Lutino, 17th Cinnamon, 17th Spangle DF, 9th AWC and 19th in the Hens Class. In 2024, Ian placed 12th and 13th in Grey Green, 11th Spangle DF, 21st Cinnamon, 3rd Dominant Pied, 20th Spangle AOSV and 12th in the Hens.

Michael Pace – I have been keeping and breeding exhibition Budgerigars for over 20 years. I have had over 50 birds represent the North QLD zone in numerous varieties with two ANBC winners in the Opaline and Normal Sky classes. In the most recent ANBC show in Cairns, I had 4th place in both the Grey Green and Normal Green classes and several other birds representing our zone. I breed around 200 plus birds annually. My blood lines began from Clint Ault birds with those lines flowing into

numerous Gazzard and Fellows birds as foundation stock. I outcross quite regularly to birds from other successful studs when I am looking to add or improve features.

Garry Gazzard - A widely respected figure in the Australian and international budgerigar fancy, Gary Gazzard is known for his exceptional breeding success with the modern budgerigar and his prestigious role as an ANBC National judge. Representing New South Wales, Gary's dedication to the exhibition of budgerigars spans decades and has earned him a place among the elite in the ANBC Hall of Fame, with a total of 10 National Class wins.

Gary first tasted national success in 1992 with dual class wins in Opaline and [Spangle](#) Combined, the latter becoming a class in which he would dominate over the years. His expertise in the Spangle variety is unmatched, claiming four wins in the Spangle Combined class—1992, 1996, 2004, and 2005—plus a notable win in Spangle Double Factor in 2004. That same year, he also achieved wins in the Blue class, showcasing the depth and versatility of his stud. Further national titles followed in Grey Green (2005), Hens Class (2007), and a second Opaline win in 2012, rounding out an outstanding career of competitive success.

Additionally, to his achievements on the show bench, Gary has made a lasting impact as a judge at the highest levels, having judged five ANBC National Shows.

Brian Walters – Open breeder and SQBBA ANBC National representative with very strong lines of cinnamons and opaline cinnamons. He has achieved a very high standard of budgies in Cinnamon or Opaline Cinnamon with 3 first place winners, one second and one third placing. He has also had success at winning Champion of Show at club annual shows. In 2018, Brian placed 11th in Opaline ASC, 10th in Opaline AOSV, in 2019, placing 3rd in Dilute, 8th in Lacewing and 16th in Opaline. In 2022 he placed 5th in Blue, 9th in Dilute and 20th in Cinnamon. At the ANBC Nationals in Ballarat in 2023 he placed 2nd in Grey Green, 7th Dilute, and 13th in Opaline AOSV and Spangle AOSV. In 2024 he placed 15th in Dilute, 20th in Lacewing and 9th in Spangle AOSV. Again in 2025 he had a strong show placing 4th and 6th in Violet, 15th in Lacewing and 19th in Dilute.

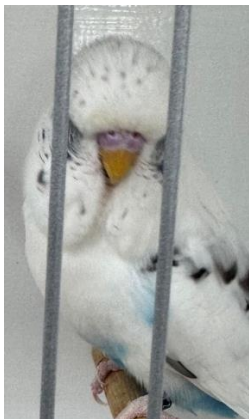

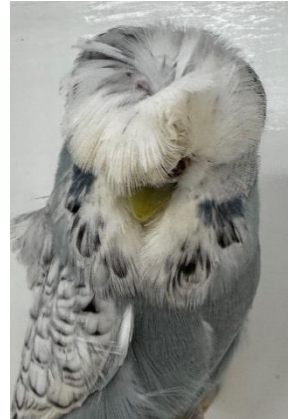

Ray Slade – Ray Slade of Victoria was proudly inducted into the ANBC Hall of Fame – Breeders Excellence Division in 2024, following a remarkable run of success at the ANBC National Show. With a total of seven national class wins, Ray’s record reflects his dedication to excellence and his impressive ability to produce top-tier birds across a range of competitive varieties.

Ray’s first national win came in 2016 with a Blackeyed Self Colour, a class known for its difficulty and exacting standard. He returned the following year to successfully defend his title in the same class, immediately establishing himself as a breeder of precision and consistency. After 2017, Ray relocated from South Australia to Victoria and became an exhibiting member of the BCV.

After several years of dedication and development, Ray made a resounding impact at the 2022 Nationals with an extraordinary four class wins in a single year—claiming top honours in the Green,

Grey, Violet, and Lacewing classes. In 2024, he added a second Grey class win to his record, bringing his total to seven and securing his well-earned place in the ANBC Hall of Fame.

Boal Family - Boal family is made of Bill Boal (40+ years breeding), Mitchell Boal (20+ years breeding) & Anthony Boal (17+ years breeding). Our stud has four main varieties being **YELLOW FACE / LACEWINGS / CLEARBODIES and CRESTS.**

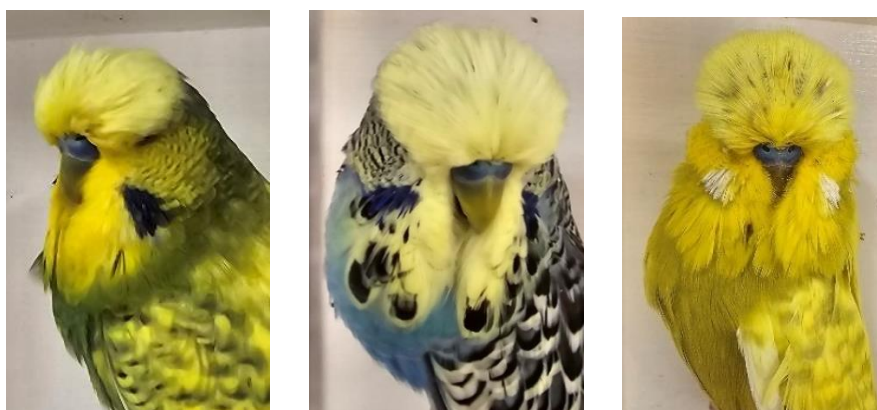

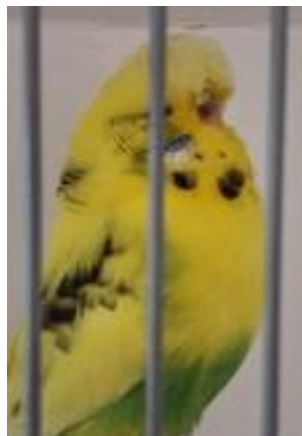

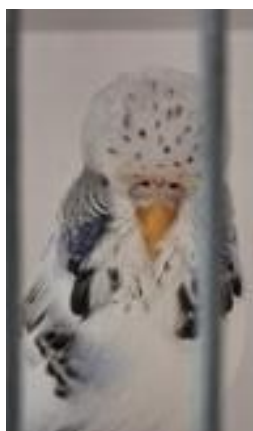
